Teen Central

- A help line website for teens, by teens
- Can anonymously submit a story/post regarding anything and receive a therapeutic support response
- Adolescents receive this support from one of TeenCentral's trained online counselors within 24-hours, safely, anonymously, and free of charge

WHO TO TALK TO?

- Online therapy sites are great resources, but costly.
- Utilize the services that school counselors offer: free, confidential support
 - Note: in the state of California, all school employees are mandated **reporters**, meaning that they are required to contact authorities if a patient is a danger to themselves, to others, and/or if they suspect that a known child is being abused
- NAMI Staff who have mental health training or certifications are mandated reporters

• Transitional Age Youth (TAY) Program

- Completely free support group Mondays (online) and Saturdays (in-person)
- Safe, confidential support space for young adults who are living with or have been affected by mental illness.
- Zoom Meetings every Mon from 6 PM-7:30 PM
- Ending the Silence is a free, evidence-based, 50-minute session designed for middle and high school students.
 - Your students will learn about mental health conditions through a brief presentation, short videos, and personal testimony from a young adult who describes their journey to recovery.
